GUNDOG

These dogs were originally trained to find live game and for to retrieve game that had been shot and wounded. This group is divided into categories - Retrievers, Spaniels, Pointers, etc.

PASTORAL

The Pastoral Group consists of herding dogs that are associated with working with reindeer and other cloven-footed animals. Usually this type of dog has a woolly double coat to protect it from the elements when working in severe conditions. Or as the Collie family, Old English Sheepdogs and Samoyeds have been herding for centuries.

TERRIER

These dogs were originally bred and used for hunting vermin. 'Terrier' comes from the Latin word Terra, meaning earth. This hardy collection of dogs were selectively bred to be extremely brave and tough and to pursue foxes, badgers, rats and others (to name but a few) above and below ground. Terriers have been known of since ancient times and, as early as the Middle Ages, these game breeds were portrayed by writers and painters.
