Diane went to the store 7 times last month. She buys 5 bottle caps each time she goes to the store. How many bottle caps did Diane buy last month?

Answer:

$$5 \text{ bottle caps} * 7 \text{ trips} = 35 \text{ bottle caps}$$

There are 5 candies in each box. How many candies are in 30 boxes?

Answer:

$$5 \text{ candies} * 30 \text{ boxes} = 150 \text{ candies}$$

Each child has 3 erasers. If there are 8 children, how many erasers are there in total?

Answer:

$$3 \text{ erasers} * 8 \text{ children} = 24 \text{ erasers}$$

There are 2 peanuts in each box. How many peanuts are in 10 boxes?

Answer:

$$2 \text{ peanuts} * 10 \text{ boxes} = 20 \text{ peanuts}$$

Each child has 9 bananas. If there are 20 children, how many bananas are there in total?

Answer:

$$9 \text{ bananas} * 20 \text{ children} = 180 \text{ bananas}$$
