1	organic	the unit of reproduction of a flowering plant, capable of developing in another such plant
2	seeds	animals kept on a farm, such as cattle or sheep
3	soil	able to continue or last for a long time
4	sustainable	a small marked or measured piece of ground for building or growing things
5	pests	a chemical substance used to kill pests
6	pesticide	a building with a glass roof and glass sides used for growing plants
7	livestock	produced without the use of pesticides, or other artificial chemicals
8	harvest	a mixture of decayed plant matter, such as grass or leaves, used for making the soil richer
9	compost	the upper layer of earth in which plants grow
10	greenhouses	being, concerning, or produced by farm animals, that are kept under natural conditions
