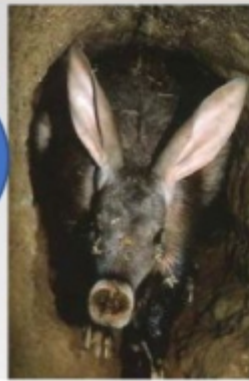

Minibeasts

The animals that eat the most grass in grasslands are not the big herbivores but the tiny insects.
