Don't Forget:

1. Add -s to words ending in a vowel.
2. Add -es to words ending in a consonant.
3. If a word ends in -ión, also drop the accent.
4. If a word ends in -z, change the z to c and add -es.

Don't forget to change the article (la to las, etc)!



los cocineros

In English, we add "The" to the beginning and usually an -s to the end of someone's last name (surname) to speak of the family:

The Smiths
The Donaldsons

In Spanish, simply add "Los":

Los Smith
Los Perez
Los Donaldson
