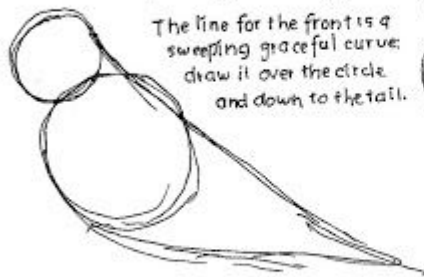
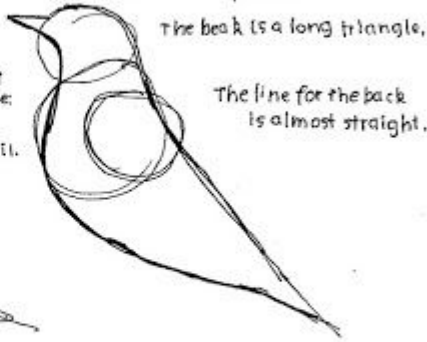


## HOW TO DRAW A ROBIN

Start with the basic shape. You can think of the robin as a teardrop shape.  
 Draw a circle for the chest and one for the head on top and a little forward.  
 The tail start as a long triangle, it is about half as long as the body.



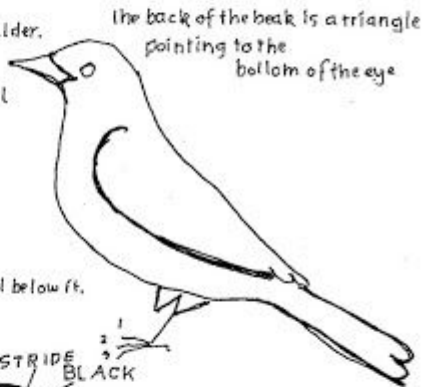
The line for the front is a sweeping graceful curve; draw it over the circle and down to the tail.



The beak is a long triangle.

The line for the back is almost straight.

The wing starts as a smaller circle on the shoulder. Draw a line down the front circle and sweep back to the tail.



The back of the beak is a triangle pointing to the bottom of the eye.

The tail is two feathers.  
 The legs start as triangles at the bottom of the bird, they are more toward the rear.  
 The legs and feet are just lines.  
 Erase the extra lines.

The robin has a black eye with white above and below it.  
 There are two or three throat stripes.  
 The head is black.

The wings and tail are grey.  
 The chest is red, to the legs  
 And white at the bottom by the tail.
