-  I am **Mercury**. I am closest to the sun. I take only 88 days to complete one journey around the sun. My neighbor, Venus and I are the only planets in the solar system which do not have any satellites.
-  I am **Mars**. I am sometimes called red planet because of the red rocks I have. I have two small satellites.
-  I am **Venus** and your closest neighbour. I shine very brightly in the sky. Though I am a planet, I am often called the 'morning star'. This is because I can be seen before sunrise. Sometimes you can see me after sunset too. Then I am called the 'evening star'.
-  I am **Uranus**. I, too, have a ring around me, but my ring is dark. I have many moons too.
-  I am **Saturn**. I look more beautiful than any other planet in the solar system, because of the rings of ice and dust particles that surround me. I have more satellites than any other planet in the solar system.
-  I am **Neptune**. I am blue in colour. I can be seen from the earth only through a telescope.
-  I am **Jupiter** and I am the biggest planet. I have sixteen moons that revolve around me.

The first letter of each word stands for each of the planet.
